

SMES Fishing Rodeo Official Rules September 29 & 30, 2023

- 1. Competition starts at 12:01AM on Friday, Sept. 29 and ends promptly at 3:00 PM on Saturday, Sept. 30.
- 2. Weigh Scales are open on Saturday from noon 3pm.
- 3. All fish must be landed by rod and reel, and only the fisherman who landed the fish can submit it to be weighed.
- 4. All Louisiana public waters are open for competition.
- 5. Participants must obey all Federal and State fishing regulations.
- 6. In the event of a tie, the first fish weighed is the winner.
- 7. The rodeo reserves the right to open all fish for examination.
- 8. The entry ticket must be presented when the fish are weighed.
- 9. Weight of the fish will be in pounds and ounces.
- 10. The fish entered for the "Stringer" category must be determined by the participant prior to weigh in. NO SUBSTITUTION IS ALLOWED.
- 11. One of the 3 fish in the "Stringer" can be entered in the largest fish category for that species of fish.
- 12. Youth category is considered 16 years and under.
- 13. Anyone found in violation of any of the rules will be ineligible for competition.
- 14. The decision of the weighmaster is final.
